



Central Bank Survey: End-February 2024

The monetary base stood at Rs169,240 million at the end of February 2024. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs82,405 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs261,842 million and Rs81,247 million, respectively.
