



Central Bank Survey: End-November 2023

The monetary base stood at Rs175,436 million at the end of November 2023. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs90,537 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs229,687 million and Rs83,231 million, respectively.
