

## **Central Bank Survey: End-April 2024**

The monetary base stood at Rs170,877 million at the end of April 2024. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs82,646 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs274,760 million and Rs83,328 million, respectively.
