



Central Bank Survey: End-April 2025

The monetary base stood at Rs182,967 million at the end of April 2025. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs89,129 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs326,604 million and Rs67,624 million, respectively.
