

Central Bank Survey: End-August 2024

The monetary base stood at Rs172,201 million at the end of August 2024. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs86,304 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs303,335 million and Rs88,146 million, respectively.
