

Central Bank Survey: End-December 2024

The monetary base stood at Rs182,335 million at the end of December 2024. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs87,085 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs336,500 million and Rs74,642 million, respectively.
