

Central Bank Survey: End-February 2025

The monetary base stood at Rs190,495 million at the end of February 2025. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs96,480 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs337,015 million and Rs83,119 million, respectively.
