

Central Bank Survey: End-January 2025

The monetary base stood at Rs182,661 million at the end of January 2025. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs88,599 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs331,612 million and Rs82,430 million, respectively.
