

Central Bank Survey: End-July 2025

The monetary base stood at Rs185,742 million at the end of July 2025. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs89,095 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs368,010 million and Rs66,863 million, respectively.
