

Central Bank Survey: End-June 2024

The monetary base stood at Rs170,183 million at the end of June 2024. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs85,632 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs327,759 million and Rs86,381 million, respectively.
