



Central Bank Survey: End-May 2024

The monetary base stood at Rs166,659 million at the end of May 2024. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs81,046 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs296,182 million and Rs85,115 million, respectively.
