



Central Bank Survey: End-November 2024

The monetary base stood at Rs182,506 million at the end of November 2024. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs93,636 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs328,098 million and Rs82,195 million, respectively.
