



Central Bank Survey: End-November 2025

The monetary base stood at Rs198,217 million at the end of November 2025. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs99,462 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs359,666 million and Rs67,098 million, respectively.
