

Central Bank Survey: End-September 2025

The monetary base stood at Rs191,793 million at the end of September 2025. Its major component, namely liabilities to Other Depository Corporations amounted to Rs94,196 million.

On the sources side of the monetary base, the net foreign assets and domestic claims of the Bank stood at Rs368,925 million and Rs65,102 million, respectively.
