



PUBLIC NOTICE

BANK OF MAURITIUS BILLS

30 June 2026

In accordance with section 6 (2) (a) of the Bank of Mauritius Act 2004 and in line with the new monetary policy framework, the Bank will issue 91-Day Bank of Mauritius Bills (BoM Bills) on **Thursday 2 July 2026**.

2. The Bank will receive bids from **all banks** for the 91-Day BoM Bills for a nominal amount of **Rs4,000 million**, to be sold through auction, in multiples of Rs100,000, on a yield basis quoted to two decimal places on **Thursday 2 July 2026** for same day settlement.
3. Banks shall submit bids for 91-Day BoM Bills, up to a maximum of **three** bids, one for each bid yield, which, however, should not exceed the tender amount.
4. Banks which are registered Bloomberg users shall submit their bids through the Bloomberg Auctioning System, whilst others should submit their bids through email on auction@bom.mu, **before 10.00 a.m. on Thursday 2 July 2026**. Bids received after the prescribed time and date shall not be considered.
5. Results of the auction will be announced on the same day and successful bidders will be required to effect payment of the cost price of the BoM Bills through the Mauritius Automated Clearing and Settlement System, **at latest by 1.00 p.m. on Thursday 2 July 2026**.
6. In the event of oversubscription of the BoM Bills, the Bank may accept a higher amount than the amount put on tender.
7. The Bank of Mauritius reserves the right to accept or reject any bid either in full or in part, without assigning any reason in respect thereof.
