### RE-OPENING OF 2.10% FIVE-YEAR GOVERNMENT OF MAURITIUS BONDS

*2 June 2021*

On 20 May 2021, the Bank of Mauritius issued a 2.10% Benchmark Five-Year Government of Mauritius Bonds maturing on 20 May 2026, for an amount of Rs2,500 million through an auction held on 18 May 2021.

2. The Bank is pleased to announce the re-opening of the 2.10% Benchmark Five-year Government of Mauritius Bonds maturing on 20 May 2026 through an auction to be held on **Wednesday 9 June 2021**, for a nominal amount of Rs2,500 million for settlement on **Friday 11 June 2021**.

3. The Bank will receive bids from Primary Dealers for this auction on the same day, i.e. **Wednesday 9 June 2021** on a **yield basis** quoted to two decimal places, in multiples of Rs100,000. Primary Dealers may submit, for their own account up to a maximum of **five bids**, one for each bid yield, which, however, should not exceed the tender amount in the aggregate.

4. Bids must be submitted before **10.00 a.m. on Wednesday 9 June 2021**. Bids received after the prescribed time and date shall not be considered.

5. In the event of oversubscription of the Bonds, the Bank may accept a higher amount than the amount put on tender.

6. The results of the auction will be announced on the same day and successful bidders will be required to effect payment of the cost price of the Bonds through the Mauritius Automated Clearing and Settlement System (MACSS) at latest by **11.00 a.m. on Friday 11 June 2021**. Payment of maturity proceeds and interest accruing on the Bonds by the Bank will also be made through the MACSS.

7. The Bonds will be issued dated **11 June 2021** and will mature and be redeemed at par by the Bank of Mauritius on **20 May 2026**. The Bank may, at its discretion, allow the Bonds to be redeemed or converted into other instruments at market rates prior to maturity.

8. Interest on these Bonds will be paid half-yearly on 20 May and 20 November by the Bank during the currency of the Bonds to the bank account of the Primary Dealers. Interest will accrue on the Bonds as from 20 May 2021 on the nominal amount allotted and will cease on the date of their maturity.

9. The cost price for the Bonds allotted will include interest from 20 May 2021 to 10 June 2021.

10. The Bonds will be issued in Book-Entry form and records will be kept at the Bank of Mauritius. The Bonds may be freely traded and are transferable from one investor to another in multiples of Rs50,000.

11. The Bank of Mauritius reserves the right to accept or reject any bid either in full or in part, without assigning any reason in respect thereof.
